

YUBA COUNTY RCD - BOARD RECRUITMENT OVERVIEW

Mission: The Yuba County Resource Conservation District (YCRCD) assists Yuba County landowners and land managers in providing stewardship of the County's natural resources and educates stakeholders and policy makers about the County's natural resource base.

Qualifications:

1. Be a registered voter in California;
2. Obtain 5 registered voter signatures; and
3. Either of the following:
 - a. If you reside within the district (Yuba County), you must either:
 - i. Own land in the district or
 - ii. Prior to applying to be director, serve as an associate director for two years.
 - b. If you are not a district resident, you must have a resident landowner appoint you as their agent. A resident landowner must submit a statement assigning the director candidate as his/her agent for the purposes of serving on the RCD board.

Terms: 4 years; End date Nov. 30th on even numbered years
Appointments are made by the County Board of Supervisors
